



GRENOSIDE STEEL WORKS

A five hole crucible steel furnace cellar dating from 1797, left relatively undisturbed since the plot was sold in 1869 after steel production there ceased. The site is (Grade 2) listed and is not normally open to the public.

The visit includes:

- An exhibition of research and artefacts found around the site.
- Local historians and metallurgist to describe its historical and industrial context and take questions.
- A short tour down stone steps in small groups (5/6) to the furnace cellar to allow for close examination.
